PRESIDENT'S REPORT SEASON 2016– 2017

The achievements of our Club during the past year will be well recorded in each of the following reports.

As your outgoing President I would like to record some of the challenges ahead so that we all can share in their coming to fruition.

The first is the redevelopment of our facilities particularly the creation of disabled toilets and new female and male toilets and changing facilities. A comprehensive submission has been with our Landlord, the Adelaide City Council for over a year now. We have put forward a request for the Council to fund this work as well as the replacement of the external windows while the Club has asked for loan assistance to undertake the replacements of ceilings, bar upgrades, new office and board room as well as external landscape. We have been assured that a decision is imminent.

All of this work is urgently needed and members should do all they can to encourage the Council to support the Club and the people of the city that increasingly use these unique parkland facilities.

The second is to continue to work on increasing all forms of membership at the Club. This particularly applies to social membership. We have many thousands of visitors each year and we must turn those 'visitors' into 'members'. This will attract revenue on the one hand but more importantly, will give us a far stronger data base when we apply for grants or chase sponsors.

The third is to recommit that the great traditional values of the Adelaide Bowling Club. As we expand our numbers both playing and social, I strongly urge all of the members to take responsibility for the mentoring of new players and members. Our presence on and off the green and our pride in our facilities must be an example to all the other Clubs whom we visit or visit us.

I have thought for some time that we need a separate small group to focus on the bowls side of the Club. The Board must deal with finance, policy, facilities, staffing, catering etc, and it does that well. The individual Clubs must have to make their own arrangements for selection, coaching, tournaments, discipline, talent development etc. AOBC and AHOS do so and it is important for ABC to do the same. Such a group could include the Chair of Selectors as well as representatives from the playing group.

The Governance of the Club is always evolving and the changes to Board makeup will be a step forward.

The strong emergence of the Metro Bowls Association is a great achievement for our game. I am very optimistic that this group will lead the emergence of perhaps new forms of our game that will be relevant for the next century.

I must record my sincere appreciation for the contributions all Board members have played over the past 5 years. It is often a thankless and the underestimated role. Those who have taken responsibility for our finances and Secretarial duties deserve special thanks. We are in a strong financial position as a result.

I also want to record my admiration for the relationship that has developed with the AOBC over the past 5 years. You are a remarkable group of people with much to share with those who are keen to learn. The model of a 'social' Club that is focused around lawn bowls is one that many may follow in the future.

We have the elite of the game like Scott Thulborn who won the World Champ of Champs, the Masters for the third time in a row, was awarded Adelaide City Council's Athlete of the Year for Adelaide and represented Australia. TREASURER'S REPORT 2016 - 2017

The club reported a net trading surplus of \$16,528 (after allowing for provisions for depreciation annual and long service leave).

Overall gross receipts were \$686,427 (2016: \$743,669) and gross expenditure was \$678,890 (2016: \$744,011). So, in general terms, both gross revenue and expenditure is down around 8%.

This net result is a more improved financial outcome than the one achieved in the prior year even though overall turnover has gone down. It should be viewed as a positive result given that the Board has reviewed the club's financial model and we are of the opinion, given our circumstances, that there is no need to change what we have currently been doing.

In fact, the Board will be very proactive in developing other revenue streams that will generate additional cash flow, especially now given the club's goals with its building re-development program, which ultimately will involve the need for finance,

The biggest drain on the club's finances is the cost of employment, The wages bill, which if I add back adjustments for provisions and include on costs, is now just exceeding \$200,000. This represents around 29% of our turnover, and if you were to consider removing catering revenue from that equation (catering income to the club basically represents a return that involves little or no labour input), then that percentage increases to 40% in real terms.

This year I have prepared and attached a short form snapshot of the club's financial accounts which summarizes certain components of the full year financial accounts and relates to the past four (4) financial years.

Given that earnings and expenses are impacted by inflationary influences, and that some rates relating to income (ie catering returns) have changed, this was prepared simply to provide a review summary of the club's financial activity over this period of time.

A simple example of this would be in relation to catering returns to the club.

As can be seen in the four year summary gross catering turnover in the 2014 year amounted to \$208,722 and the return to the club was \$23,136. This year gross turnover was down to \$188,260, but our return was \$28,481. This came about by our negotiations with the caterer to increase our rate to 20% of gross turnover. This now more than covers our direct overheads, where-as in the past this was not the case

It would be fair to say that most of the figures presented are fairly consistent and that where there has been a drop in revenue, there has been a resultant drop in expenditure which can be put down to good management. Obviously, there will be timing differences from year to year, but in general there is consistency in our business.

As previously mentioned the financial accounts are always monitored regularly and it would appear that all measuring parameters and cost ratios have been consistently maintained.

The club is still in a reasonably strong financial position and I cannot see any reason why the club cannot maintain its financial objectives and business goals going forward and that the same work and business ethics are employed by the incoming committee.

We should really see the benefit of this through the upcoming season and will be looking at doing the same work to A or C green this coming Christmas.

The clubs Machinery is all in good working order with only small problems throughout the season.

The clubs surrounds and gardens are starting to look great but still a long way to go. This is due to the great work of our newly formed grounds crew 'The Monday Morning Blues' have
