



WORK, HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

GENERAL POLICY:

BOARD OF MANAGEMENT

THE BOARD OF MANAGEMENT WILL:

- Undertake to provide a safe and healthy working environment for all employees, Club members and visitors.
- Observe and enforce the relevant acts and regulations that apply to working conditions in the industry.
- Provide information and training in the correct use of all equipment and materials being used in this business.
- Be responsible for the safety, health and working conditions of all employees under their control.
- Rectify and follow up action on all matters concerning health and safety with hazards as they are observed.

EMPLOYEES

EMPLOYEES ARE:

- To cooperate willingly in the objective of making this a healthy and safe workplace.
- Required to observe and practice safe work methods.
- To ensure that protective clothing and equipment is used as required and used correctly at all times.
- To immediately make safe (if possible) and then report any unsafe work conditions or equipment to the management of the Club.
- Ensure that they are not, by the consumption of alcohol or a drug in such a state to endanger their own safety at work or the safety of any other person at work.
